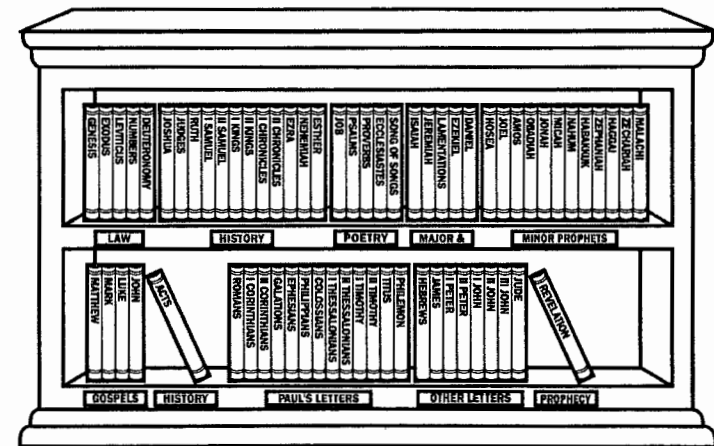

Of the Faith

Note for the Parents

In your child's class we will now be studying Series C, "God's Wonderful Library". This series is designed to help them learn that the source of all true knowledge about God is found in the Bible alone. Below is an outline of the lessons in this series including the questions, answers and memory verses your child will be memorizing.

Lesson 1, Where do you learn how to love and obey God?

- Where do you learn how to love and obey God? (*In the Bible alone.*)
- Who wrote the Bible? (*Holy men who were taught by the Holy Spirit.*)
- Memory Verse: II Peter 1:21, "For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit," II Peter 1:21.

Lesson 2, Why Did God Give the Bible To Us?

- Why did God give the Bible to us? (*God gave the Bible to teach us about Himself and to show us how to live.*)
- Memory Verse: Psalm 119:11, "I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You," Psalm 119:11.

Lesson 3, Why Did God Give the Old Testament To Us?

- Why did God give the Old Testament to us? (*God gave the Old Testament to teach us how He prepared the way for the promised Savior.*)
- Memory Verse: Zechariah 2:10, "'Shout and be glad, O Daughter of Zion. For I am coming, and will live among you,' declares the Lord," Zechariah 2:10.

Lesson 4, Why Did God Give the New Testament To Us?

- Why did God give the New Testament to us? (*God gave the New Testament to tell us the good news that the Savior has come.*)
- Memory Verse: John 20:31, "But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name," John 20:31.

Lesson 5, What Do the Old and New Testaments Promise About the Risen Savior?

- What do the Old and New Testaments promise about the risen Savior? (*The Old and New Testaments promise that He will come again for all His children.*)
- Memory Verse: Hebrews 9:28b, "He will appear a second time, not to bear, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for Him," Hebrews 9:28b.
