

Check-In Procedures

We strive to help create a safe, nurturing, and loving environment for your child.

*Please make sure your child is registered with the Nursery Ministry. Complete an information card for each child in your family who will be using the nursery services.

*For the 0-2 year old nursery, please sign your child in on the sign-in sheet and indicate any dietary needs or preferences. All bottles, sippy cups, and diaper bags must be clearly labeled with the child's name.

*For the toddlers, please tell the teachers if your child wears diapers /pull ups or if they are potty trained. Provide your own diapers please.

*Only parents or authorized adults are allowed to drop-off and pick up children. Older siblings are not permitted to pick up a child.

*Please refrain from checking on your child during the session. It is upsetting to the children and can be very disruptive. Our teachers will take good care of your children. If your child has an emergency or cries longer than 5-10 minutes, you will be notified.



Volunteer Needs

We can always use more teenage and adult volunteers for this ministry. All of our adult volunteers must complete a volunteer form as well as pass a Criminal Record check, as well as a PA Child Abuse Clearance.

Teenage volunteers must be in at least 7th grade to help with the 2-4 year olds and at least 9th grade to help with the 0-2 year olds. It is up to the discretion of the nursery coordinator to determine whether an interested teenager will be able to serve in the nursery.

SNACK POLICY

Due to food allergies & sensitivities to peanuts and tree nuts, the nursery rooms offer snacks that are nut allergen-free. We believe it's important for our nursery rooms to be a safe environment, and as much as possible, minimize/eliminate the risk of exposure to nut allergens.

There will be a light snack time during each class. They will be given a basic snack of Cheerios, graham crackers, goldfish crackers, or something similar along with water or juice to drink.

Please note any allergies or food restrictions on your registration card and indicate that on the sign-in sheet.

Outside snacks from home are discouraged unless there are specific needs.

Nursing Mothers

Nursing mothers are welcome to use the room adjacent to the birth- 2 year old Nursery. Please enter the nursing room through the birth- 2 year old room.

Please bring only plastic feeding bottles. Bottles brought by parents will be given according to parents' instructions. If you need to nurse your baby, let the teachers know when you will be planning to come back and nurse your child.

Welcome to the Children's Ministry and Church Nursery of Three Rivers Grace Church. Coming alongside parents to reach the next generation for Christ is the focus of our Children's Ministries. Our purpose is to teach God's Word and see young lives transformed as they grow in their faith. Our classes are biblically based, age-appropriate and child friendly. Our teachers are trained and use curriculum from Regular Baptist Press (RBP) Ministries, and are carefully screened before they teach any child.

Additionally, nursery care is available during the worship service starting at 10:45 a.m. for babies through Pre-K4. These classes are planned developmentally for each age and are taught directly through God's Word.

Sick Policy

For the health of all of our children and workers, we ask that parents not bring their child to the nursery or Sunday School rooms if he/she has:

- * A fever or has had one in the past 24 hours
- * Diarrhea or has had in the past 24 hours
- * A fresh cold
- * Nasal discharge unrelated to allergies
- * A constant cough
- * Nausea or vomiting in past 24 hours
- * A rash on face or body
- * Seems unusually tired or cranky
- * Strep throat, if within first 24 hours
